Information

LUCIFER (Latin derivation of הֵילֵל, *heilel*). The morning star; an epithet of Venus. A title given to the king of <u>Babylon</u> (<u>Isa 14:12</u>). The early church fathers began to apply the term to <u>Satan</u>, possibly due to the belief that he had fallen from heaven (<u>Luke 10:18</u>).
